#### PROCEEDINGS OF ANNUAL MEETING APRIL 18, 2017

The Annual meeting for the Town of Oconto was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Patrick Scanlan. Present: Supervisors Paul Pansier and Steve Carlin, Clerk Lori Scanlan, Treasurer Mandy Leonard. All others present signed the registry. (18 town residents, 3 non town residents (guests)

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Chairman stated that the votes need to be tallied by voice, show of hands, standing, etc. Motion by Tom Bitter, 2nd by Gayle Lukas to use show of hands. 18 ayes, 0 nays M/C.

Minutes of last Annual Meeting held on April 19, 2016, are located at front of Annual Audit Report. Motion made by Doug Schroeder, 2nd by John Bickel to dispense with reading of minutes and approve with correction noted of recycling center closing times at 4:15 pm on Friday and 1:45 pm on Saturday. 18 ayes, 0 nays M/C

Treasurer Leonard gave summary of Financial Report located at back of Annual Report. Motion made by Doug Schroeder, 2nd by John Bickel to accept and approve the Financial Report for the year 2016 (Jan.1, 2016 through Dec. 31, 2016) as printed in the Annual Report. 18 ayes, 0 nays. M/C.

Treasurer gave budget summary located in the Annual Report. Motion made by Karl Ballestad, 2nd by John Bickel to approve as printed. 18 ayes, 0 nays M/C.

Treasurer Leonard reported that our town website townofoconto.com is up and running and Due North came in under quote. After initial set up costs, it will cost \$120 a year to host. We will post all agendas, minutes, etc. on the website. However, the agendas still need to be posted in the three designated spots (Town Hall, Irish Greens Golf Club and the Recycling Center)

Treasurer reported that starting with this year's tax collection the Town of Oconto will be requiring proof of rabies vaccinations for dog licensing. This will be noted on the tax roll when sent out and also on the website. State statutes show 'upon presentation of evidence that the dog is currently immunized against rabies, the collecting official shall complete and issue to the owner a license for the dog..."

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Chairman reminded everyone a burning permit is needed and you must call in and report that you are burning to the fire department and Sheriff department. Phone numbers for DNR are located in center of permit to call to see if burning is allowed on that day.

Chairman reported on year 2016 road work completed: Winter maintenance was \$49,270.00 for 2016 Winter. Routine maintenance was done throughout the year (crack sealing, mowing, brushing, tree trimming, signs, culvert replacement on Delcore and Funk, etc.) Total of \$232,502 was spent on the town's transportation system. Hoehne Lane reconstruction of .78 miles was done by Richlein Construction and Oconto County Highway Dept. at a cost of approx. \$117,858.00 There was several culvert failures with 36" and greater which qualified for Bridge Aid for a 50% reimbursement. Elm Grove School Road, Logtown Road and Hoehne Lane culverts were done at a cost of \$20,198 of which approx. \$10,099 reimbursement will be realized.

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Recycling Center Hours currently are Friday from 2:00 pm to 4:15 pm and Saturday from 9:00 am to 1:45 p.m. Motion made by Tom Bitters, 2nd by John Bickel to keep hours same. 18 ayes, 0 nays, M/C.

Wages to be paid for hours worked in year 2018 were set as follows: Recycling Attendant in Charge and Chief Inspector rate of pay currently is \$14.00. Motion made by Tom Bitters, 2nd by Doug Schroeder to keep it the same @ \$14.00 per hr. 18 ayes, 0 nays. M/C.

Election worker pay is currently at \$13.00. Motion made by Lori Scanlan 2nd by Karen Carlin to keep it at \$13.00 per hr. 18 ayes, 0 nays, M/C.

Worker hour pay is currently at \$12.50 hr. Motion made by Paul Pansier, 2nd by John Bickel to keep it the same. 18 ayes, 0 nays. M/C.

Mileage is at .53 cents per mile. Motion made by Paul Pansier, 2nd by Tom Bitters to keep it the same. 18 ayes, 0 nays M/C.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Truck is at \$14.00 per hour. Motion made by Paul Pansier, 2nd by Doug Schroeder to keep it the same. 18 ayes, 0 nays, M/C.

Tractor is at \$30.00 per hour. Motion made by Steve Carlin, 2nd by Paul Pansier to keep it the same. 18 ayes, 0 nays. M/C.

Chainsaw is at \$9.00 hr. Motion made by Paul Pansier, 2nd by Tom Bitters to keep chain saw rate at \$9.00 hr. 18 ayes, 0 nays, M/C.

Trimmer/Mower is currently at \$15.00 hr. Motion made by Brad Leonard, 2nd by Paul Pansier to keep Trimmer at \$15.00 hr. 18 ayes, 0 nays M/C.

Motion made by Tom Bitters, 2nd by Pat Scanlan that it be the Town Board's right to transfer funds as they see fit within accounts. 18 ayes, 0 nays. M/C.

Crime Stoppers of Oconto County sent request for donation. No action taken: postponed.

Oconto County Economic Development Corporation sent request for funding at a cost of \$500 donation. No action taken: postponed.

Chairman announced that he and the Supervisors will be conducting Road Review and culverts this year on May 8 and 9th, 2017. The Pacer rating system will be used where they rate the conditions of roads and submit to Department of Transportation. Chairman also noted that the town will be getting some ditching done on Frog Pond road through grant funding for Northern Pike.

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Dave Dreshek and Ron Rauscher were present from the Oconto ATV Club to explain their request to have Town of Oconto roads open to ATV/UTV vehicles. Discussion held. Currently work is being done on drafting a Memorandum of Agreement for town road use. We are expecting to have this completed by early Summer. Dreshek stated that the ultimate goal is to be able to hook up to the Nicolet State Trail.

Application of Liquid Animal Manure Spraying was discussed. Gayle Lukas suggested the town take proactive steps to prevent the spraying of liquid manure by way of pivot spraying by issuing an ordinance or referendum. Discussion held. Chairman informed everyone that this is all being researched and investigating as to how the town would enforce this ordinance. Currently the county's Land Conservation Department is in charge of working as mediator and helping with enforcement. Tom Bitters stated this is a Right to Farm state and we need to be sure we are not infringing on their rights to farm. It was also noted that all this would need to go through the permit process at the county level (Land Conservation Dept.). This topic will be an agenda item at May 2017 meeting.

Karl Ballestad thanked the current town board for a job well done the last term.

Vi Bourassa asked the clerk why only one election machine (touch screen) was used at last two elections (February and April) and why we don't program the paper ballot election machine. Clerk stated that the touch screen is handicap accessible and MUST always be programed. County Clerk has input on what machines should be programmed and used. The paper ballot machine requires additional expenses to program and to print ballots. Typically it is only programed when voter turnout is expected to be high (Presidential, etc.) There are always absentee ballots available or you can request to get a paper ballot and then a hand tally at end of the night is done. Clerk explained election workers are encouraging all voters to give the touch screen a try, but would certainly let paper ballot be voted if voter refuses to use the touch screen.

Next Annual meeting will be held on the THIRD Tuesday in April 2018. (April 17, 2018 at 7:00pm at the Town of Oconto Town Hall.)

The Sanitary District had approximately one half mile of the gravity sewer line televised this year. Several areas of concern were found but repairs could not be made due to the schedules of contractors. We intend to have another half mile televised in 2018. We also had to replace the two grinder pumps at the Pine street lift station. These two pumps were original to the system and had been in service for 20 years. The new pumps should lessen the problems we had with blockages at the Pine Street station.

We have budgeted to replace the two pumps in the Frog Pond Station in 2018. These pumps are also 20 years old. One of them is failing and we are concerned that both of these pumps have a limited future.

Our meetings are held the first Monday of the month at the Town Hall. The meetings are called to order at 3:45. Notices of our meetings are posted at the Town Hall, the recycling center and the Cream City Supper Club.
